<u>Healthy Heights:</u> Read nutrition labels for actual serving size and ingredients. One of the most common mistakes people make when reading food labels is not calculating the nutritional values based on number of servings of a particular food item.

<u>Health News:</u> The single, most important act we can do to prevent infection is good handwashing! Soap and water coupled with friction for 10-15 sec and drying our hands well, are all-important aspects of handwashing. This simple act can prevent the spread of germs from one part of our body to other parts of our body, and to others in our family and classrooms. Additional acts that will help:

- 1. Cover coughs and sneezes
- 2. Use a Kleenex vs your hands or sleeves
- 3. Stay home with a temperature of 100 degrees or greater
- 4. Do not pick at scabs
- 5. Cover any sores that are blistered, moist or draining
- 6. Get a flu shot
