

BASICS OF THE AHISD BOND: The AHISD Board of Trustees has called for a \$135 million bond issue election to be held on Saturday, May 6, 2017. Early voting is 24 April to 2 May 2017. Every penny of bond revenue stays in the district (No "Robinhood"/Recapture). Seniors age 65+ generally have frozen school taxes. Estimated debt service tax rate implication: 5.5 cents per \$100 valuation. The total amount is \$135 million.
